RE: COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT – CDBG PROJECTS/REVIEW HEARING

Marie Cox, Columbiana County Development Department, reported on the County's Fair Housing Program, noting the area receiving CDBG funds must comply with the local fair housing regulations. Ms. Cox reported on the Development's past and present performance of housing activities, which must help the low and moderate- income individuals in the funded areas. General Fair Housing Brochure packages were presented to the attending communities and representatives to be taken back to their areas for distribution. Information was presented on the requirements of meeting Federal Regulations that you may freely choose a place to live without regard to your race, color, religion, sex, national origin or because you are disabled or have children in your family. Information was given for use to contact the County's Fair Housing Agency.
