**PROCLAMATION**

Whereas, some Columbiana County residents are recovering with mental illnesses, addictions, or both;

Whereas, these residents come from all walks of life and all backgrounds; mental illnesses and addictions are "equal opportunity" illnesses;

Whereas, mental illnesses and addictions are treatable diseases, people with these diseases can and do recover;

Whereas, stigma, which is a negative judgment based on the erroneous beliefs that mental illnesses and addictions are personal weaknesses, and people with these illnesses should be avoided, impedes recovery;

Whereas, stigma breeds misunderstanding, encourages people with mental illnesses or addictions to become isolated, and discourages them from seeking help;

Whereas, stigma breeds discrimination and causes recovering people unnecessary shame, which interferes with their recovery;

Whereas, people recovering with mental illnesses and addictions have talents and skills to offer in their families, their workplace, and in our communities, and stigma thwarts these contributions.

THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners encourages all residents of Columbiana County to help "Stomp Out Stigma" by becoming educated about mental illness, addiction, and recovery.
