RESOLUTION NO. 21-2013

IN THE MATTER OF ESTABLISHING DOG REGISTRATION AND KENNEL FEES FOR COLUMBIANA COUNTY:

WHEREAS, the Columbiana County Board of Commissioners desire an increase in the current dog license and kennel fees under Chapter 955 of the Ohio Revised Code;

WHEREAS the Columbiana County Board of Commissioners (the "Board") desire to increase the dog license fee to Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each individual dog license; and

WHEREAS, sections 955.01 and 955.14 of the Revised Code, as recently amended by 2013 HB59, effective on July 1, 2013, now permit dog owners to obtain three-year or permanent dog registrations; and

WHEREAS, a three-year dog registration shall be charged a fee equal to three times the annual dog registration fee; and

WHEREAS, a permanent dog registration shall be charged a fee equal to ten times the annual dog registration fee;

WHEREAS, sections 955.04 and 955.14 of the Revised Code requires owners of dog kennels to make application for the registration of such kennel, and pay to the county auditor a registration fee, which fee shall be equal to five (5) times the annual dog registration fee; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Columbiana County, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Board, having estimated that the fees established in this Resolution are needed to pay all expenses for the administration of Chapter 955 of the Revised Code and to pay claims allowed for animals injured or destroyed by dogs, hereby establishes the following dog registration and kennel fees for Columbiana County:

Registration Period	Fee
One year registration	\$10.00
Three year registration	\$30.00
Permanent registration	\$100.00
Kennel Fee	\$50.00 up to 5 tags, additional \$1.00 per tag pursuant to ORC 955.04

Section 2. The dog registration and kennel fees established herein shall be effective on December 1, 2013.
