

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING #2

Columbiana County intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development for funding under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Economic Development Program, a federally-funded program administered by the State. On January 31, 2011 the County conducted its first public hearing to inform citizens about the CDBG program, how it may be used, what activities are eligible, and other important program requirements.

Based on both citizens input and local officials' assessment of the county's needs, the County is proposing to undertake the following CDBG Economic Development activity for Fiscal Year 2010.
